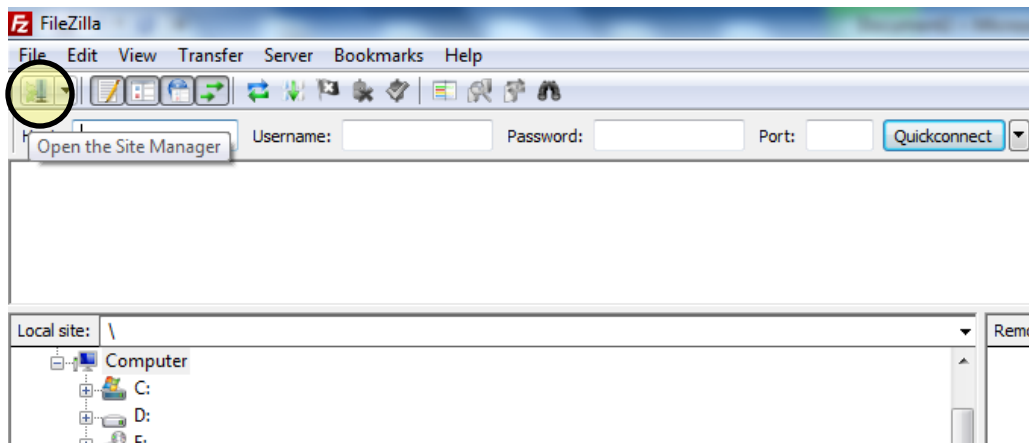


Connecting to your Student Website Using FTPS in Windows

1. If you have not already done so, download and install FileZilla. <http://filezilla-project.org/>
2. Open FileZilla and click the “Site Manager” button from the top menu.



3. In the Site Manager window, Click “New Site”. You may name the site whatever you would like but we recommend naming it “students.dsu.edu”.

4. Enter the following information.

Host: **students.dsu.edu**

Protocol: **FTP – File Transfer Protocol**

Encryption: **Require explicit FTP over TLS**

Login Type: **Normal**

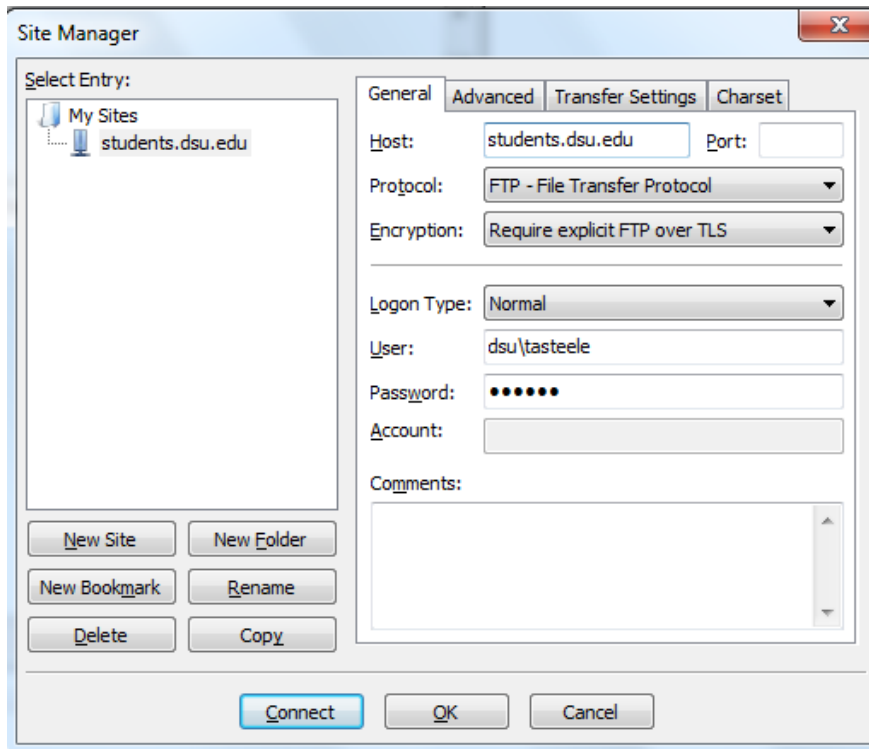
Username: **Your Username**

Password: **Your Password**

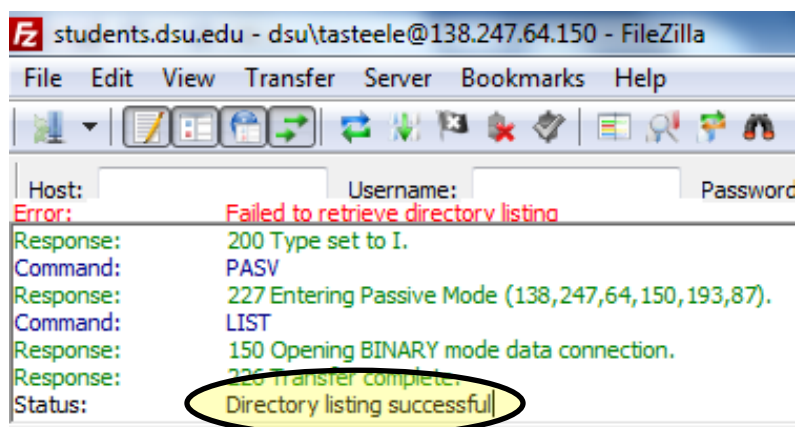

5. Once all of your information is entered, click “Connect”.
6. It should now say “Directory listing successful” in the message box.
